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1. Purpose of the Notice

This Newsletter Consent Notice explains how ECOSYN Foundation collects and uses personal data when an individual subscribes to receive newsletters, announcements, updates, publications, event information, or other informational communications from the Foundation.

The purpose of this Notice is to make the consent process clear and to explain how subscribers may withdraw consent at any time.

2. What Subscribers Consent To

By subscribing to the ECOSYN Foundation newsletter, the subscriber consents to receiving electronic communications from ECOSYN Foundation.

- Foundation activities and institutional updates;
- project and partnership announcements;
- publications, reports, policy documents, and notices;
- events, webinars, meetings, and public initiatives;
- research, innovation, sustainability, social impact, and cooperation updates;
- other information related to the legitimate activities of ECOSYN Foundation.

3. Personal Data Collected

For newsletter subscription purposes, ECOSYN Foundation may collect the subscriber's email address, name, organization, language preference, subscription date, consent record, unsubscribe status, and technical information necessary to manage delivery and security.

ECOSYN Foundation does not request unnecessary personal data for newsletter subscription. Subscribers should not provide sensitive personal data through newsletter subscription forms.

4. Legal Basis

The primary legal basis for sending newsletter communications is consent. By actively subscribing, the subscriber indicates a clear wish to receive ECOSYN Foundation communications.

Where required, ECOSYN Foundation may keep a record of the subscription and consent to demonstrate that communications were requested by the subscriber.

5. Unsubscribe and Withdrawal of Consent

Subscribers may withdraw consent at any time. Withdrawal may be made through the unsubscribe link included in newsletter emails or by contacting ECOSYN Foundation directly at the email address listed below.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before consent was withdrawn. After withdrawal, ECOSYN Foundation will stop sending newsletter communications unless there is another lawful reason to communicate with the individual.

6. Data Sharing and Processors

ECOSYN Foundation may use trusted service providers to manage newsletter delivery, mailing list administration, security, and technical hosting. Such service providers may process subscriber data only on behalf of ECOSYN Foundation and subject to appropriate safeguards.

ECOSYN Foundation does not sell, rent, trade, or transfer newsletter subscriber data to third parties for their own marketing purposes.

7. Retention

Newsletter subscription data is retained for as long as the subscription remains active or as long as necessary to manage unsubscribe requests, maintain suppression lists, and demonstrate consent where required.

Unsubscribed email addresses may be retained in a suppression list to ensure that further newsletter communications are not sent inadvertently.

8. Rights of Subscribers

Subscribers have rights under applicable data protection law, including the right to request access, correction, erasure, restriction, objection, portability where applicable, and withdrawal of consent.
